

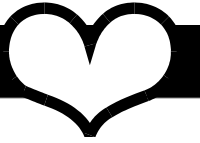

OPERATION ARCHANGEL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

We need to set up a Safety Team for St. Paul's Church.
