This Christmas we are once again offering the community of St. Paul's the opportunity to step away from the commercialism and hustle & bustle of the season.

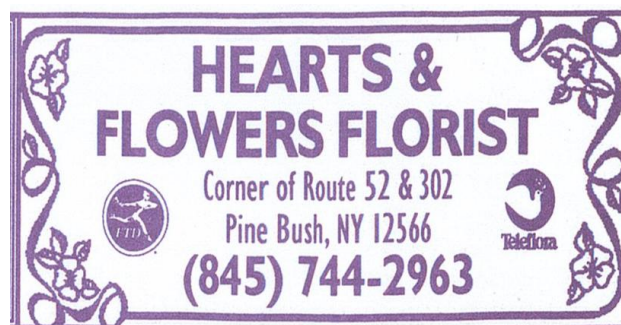
