HEALING MASS

The monthly Healing Mass at **The National Shrine of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel** will take place on Thursday evening, **July 27th at 7:00pm** with a special focus on Blessed Titus Brandsma, whose feast day we will celebrate on July 27th. Born in Bolsward, The Netherlands in 1881, Blessed Titus Brandsma joined the Carmelite order and was ordained a priest in 1905. He was a professor of philosophy and of the history of mysticism in the Catholic University of Nijmegen, Holland and was a professional journalist who fought, faithful to the Gospel, against the spread of Nazi ideology and for the freedom of Catholic education and of the Catholic press. He was eventually arrested and sent to a succession of prisons and concentration camps where he brought comfort and peace to his fellow prisoners while a prisoner himself. He was killed at Dachau and was beatified by John Paul II on November 3, 1985. All are invited to attend.
