
14th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

JULY 6, 2025



The 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C, calls us to reflect on God's care, the message of the Cross and the call to discipleship. Through the readings, we see the joy of trusting in God, the importance of humility, and the hope found in sharing his love with others. These themes encourage us to rejoice in God's blessings, rely on Jesus and embrace the mission he has given us.

The first reading from Isaiah illustrates God's care for his people. The prophet speaks of Jerusalem as a mother who comforts and nurtures her children. Just as a mother provides for her child, God offers comfort and hope to his people, even in times of struggle. It calls us to trust and find peace in him.

The Gospel reading from Luke tells of Jesus sending out 72 disciples to spread his message. This event highlights the importance of mission, the inclusion of all people and reliance on God's guidance.

Luke's Gospel often emphasizes Jesus' outreach to the marginalized and his call for social justice. By sending disciples ahead, Jesus shows the need to share God's love with everyone, especially those on the fringes of society. This mission reflects Luke's focus on compassion and the universal offer of salvation.

As we reflect on peace, joy and discipleship, we are reminded of God's blessings and the hope we find in Christ.
