Liturgy: What the parish suggested	What we've done
Involve children in liturgy; have representatives of ministries speak to students and parents about what is involved and how they can be part of it. (music, ushers, greeters, altar servers)	Each month students in one RE class sign up for different ministries and work side by side with the adults to serve at Mass.

Community: What the parish suggested	What we've done
Monthly name and tags and coffee hours on a regular schedule (consistency).	Parish Life Weekend first weekend each month.: Socials after both Masses. Sunday Coffee Hours, hosted by RE classes or ministries.
Meet with 20–30-year-old parishioners to get ideas on how they might feel more connected. =	Generations United, an organization of young and old, plans monthly activities for the parish.
Welcome the homebound watching Mass at home, continue home visits and add calls.	Homebound recognized on streaming Sundays.

Formation: What the parish suggested	What we've done
More sessions after Mass for growing spiritually- short sessions that you can attend as you're able. Consider offering some of our programs in person and evenings.	We tried a variety of offerings: After Mass Sundays, 2 fall sessions on Lectio Divina & 1 in winter on the Examen.. Gospel discussions after 3 Sunday Masses during Lent Evening Lenten reflection on <u>No Greater Love</u> on zoom

Outreach: What the parish suggested	What we've done
Let parishioners know more specifically how we are serving the community and how they can help.	A poster informs parishioners of Food Pantry Sunday. The Youth Ministry invited parishioners to bring items for the homeless.
Continue to involve RE students in outreach.	

Communication: What the parish suggested	What we've done
Identify Parish Council Members as liaisons who can take their needs, suggestions to Father.	
Keep parishioners aware of activities going on Having representatives from ministries share at Mass. Make sure everyone is on the Flock Note Email list	Highlighting ministries in the bulletin
Let Parishioners know what is happening in Religious Education	Introduction of Sacramental candidates and Prayer Partners
