Although we have not officially resumed the sign of peace, people seem to be doing so spontaneously. If you give the sign of peace, please be sure not to make your neighbor uncomfortable by requiring physical contact.

Simply saying "Peace be with you" to your neighbor is sufficient and safe.

If you are going to receive communion on the tongue, please wait until the end of the communion line to receive.

Parishioners who are fully vaccinated have the option of using a face mask in the Main Church and the East Wing of the church. It is certainly acceptable to continue wearing face masks since we will all be in a closed space for a significant period of time with many people. You may also want to wear a face covering if you are still concerned about your own vulnerability or the vulnerability of others, especially young children.
